

## SEQUOYAH PLANNING II, LLC PRIVACY POLICY

In establishing an advisory account with Sequoyah Planning II, LLC (“Adviser”), it is necessary that you provide Adviser with certain personal financial information necessary to manage your account in a manner consistent with your investment objectives and personal financial goals.

### Types of Nonpublic Personal Information We Collect

Adviser collects nonpublic personal information about you that is provided by you or obtained by Adviser with your authorization. Adviser may collect nonpublic personal information about you from the following sources:

- Information Adviser receives from you on applications or other forms, and
- Information about your securities transactions with Adviser or other advisers and broker/dealers which may be providing financial services to you.

### Parties to Whom We Disclose Information

It is the policy of Adviser that we do not disclose any nonpublic personal information about our clients or former clients to unaffiliated third parties, except as permitted by law. When necessary to provide all of the services you request for your account, Adviser may provide nonpublic personal information about you to certain third parties, such as clearing firms that serve or may serve as the custodian of your account, or that may effect securities transactions on your behalf, or insurance companies. Such disclosure is only made to fulfill our duties to you in fully servicing your account. Under no circumstances do we sell your name or other information to anyone.

### Protecting the Confidentiality and Security of Clients’ Information

Adviser retains records relating to professional services that we provide so that we are better able to assist you with your needs. Adviser restricts access to your personal and account information to those employees who need to know that information to provide products or services to you. Adviser maintains physical, electronic, and procedural safeguards to guard your non-public personal information. If you decide to close your account(s) with Adviser or become an inactive customer, Adviser will adhere to the privacy policies and practices as described in this notice.
